





### GGCOA Supports Member for RAM Event

The U.S. Public Health Service Commissioned Corps partnered with Remote Area Medical (RAM) to provide, for the fourth year in a row, a clinic for underserved persons prior to the annual USPHS Scientific and Training Symposium. This year's clinic provided free dental and vision and was held in partnership with the Salvation Army Harbor Light Center in downtown Minneapolis, MN, on Saturday, May 3 and Sunday, May 4.

Sixty four (64) Commissioned Corps officers supported the two-day RAM event, including our own GGCOA member LCDR Jason Wilken, CDC Career Epidemiology Field Officer assigned to the California Department of Public Health. LCDR Wilken, a member of the Scientist Category, served as a Safety Officer during the RAM event.

The clinic served 202 patients, and provided 269 patient services (vision and/or dental). Senior Commissioned Corps leadership including VADM Jerome Adams, RADM Sylvia Trent-Adams, RADM Erica Schwartz, RADM Susan Orsega, and Chief Professional Officers RADM Edward Dieser (Engineer), RADM Ty Bingham (Pharmacist), and CAPT Jeanean Willis-March (Health Services) visited the clinic on Sunday, and the Assistant Secretary for Health, ADM Brett Giroir, worked in the vision clinic on Saturday and Sunday. The event was a great success, with positive feedback from participants thanking officers for the service and a request from the Salvation Army Harbor Lights Center to hold another RAM event in 2020.

This was the third pre-USPHS Scientific and Training Symposium deployment for LCDR Wilken. "These deployments are particularly gratifying because of their immediate impact," said LCDR Wilken. "This is an underserved population, they're coming to the clinic because they might not have any other real opportunities for dental or vision care. I see them leave the clinic with a new pair of glasses or with relief from their dental pain, and I know that our mission has made a difference for hundreds of people."
